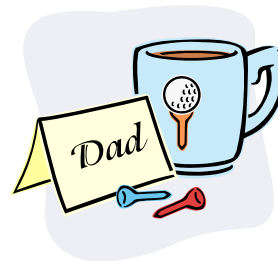

Business of the Month: Eatza Pizza

Looking for something different for dinner tonight? Feeling like pizza? Then head on over to Castroville's newest pizza place, Eatza Pizza, located on Hwy 90 next to True Value.

This family owned and operated business opened their second location this past December and Castroville residents have been able to sample their delicious specialty pizzas and a salad bar that seems to have just about everything you'd want.

"Our salad bar has over 30 fresh items to choose from," says co-owner Steve Mahler. "And it's everyday from 11am until 15 minutes before we close."

Owners Steve Mahler, Keith Luff and Heather Luff Vaughan were excited to open a location in Castroville, especially since Keith and Heather grew up here. Many family members

work at both of their locations and can usually be seen in the stores on a daily basis.

They offer a lunch and dinner buffet of pizza, salad or both, Monday –Friday from 11am to 2pm and 5pm to 8pm and on Saturday and Sunday from 11am to 5pm. Don't see the pizza you like on the buffet? Just ask them and they'll make it for you.

One thing that makes their pizza unique is that the dough is made fresh throughout the day and is never frozen. They use a three cheese blend consisting of mozzarella, provolone and white cheddar and their sauce is made in the restaurant on a daily basis.

They have over twenty-five fresh toppings to choose from and five different sauces. Choose from thin or original crust and try their specialty pizzas.

Perhaps you will want to try the Completza Pizza which has several types of meats, cheeses, and veggies. Or how about the Chicken Bacon Ranch with a ranch sauce, grilled chicken, bacon pieces. In the mood for something a little spicy? Try to Heatza Pizza with a spicy marinara sauce.

They also have several sizes to choose from including a 12", 16" and the extra large 28" pizza! It's the perfect addition to your next get together or team party.

Looking for something other than pizza? Try their 1/3 pound angus burger, five varieties of sub sandwiches, pasta dishes and appetizers including baked wings, fried pickles, fried mushrooms, cheese sticks, fries and onion rings.

And to calm that sweet tooth try their Treatza pizzas with apple, peach, pineapple or

cherry topping or how about fried ice cream?

And if you're looking for a place to host your next event, check out the huge party room Eatza Pizza has to offer. And their extensive game room has several games to choose from including a pool table and multiple video games.
