## Private Parties at the Pool

**Private Party Reservations** - includes lifeguards and all pool facilities. Best times for booking are any Fri., Sat., or Sun. evenings and Sat. and Sun. late-mornings.

Fee **\$95.00** per hour, 2 hour minimum

**Pool Pavilion Reservations** - great for birthdays, team parties, club functions, and family gatherings. Pavilion reservations for group parties are for use during “Daily Swim” hours.

Fee **\$25.00** per hour, plus daily fees

## Swim Programs

Registration for Learn-to-Swim, Swim Camp, and Parent/Toddler Lessons must be done at the pool on one of the following two dates and times

- The Fee for each activity is **\$60.00** per child, due at Registration.
- Children registering for lessons should come to the pool in swim suits to take a 5-minute water skills test. This ensures proper level placement. (If a child has a current Swim Card from last year's lessons, it may be presented at Registration for proper placement. The water test may be exempted.)
- Session dates and times will be selected at Registration.
- Make checks payable to City of Castroville.
- No telephone registration will be taken.
- Fees for registering after these two dates is **\$70.00** and is contingent upon availability of instructors.

## Learn-to-Swim

Learn-to-Swim teaches aquatic and safety skills in a logical progression. The objective is to teach people to swim and to be safe in, on, and around the water. Skills are categorized into five Learn-to-Swim levels. The levels and the objectives for each level include:

- **Level 1** Introduction to Water Skills: helps students feel comfortable in the water and to enjoy the water safely.
- **Level 2** Fundamental Aquatic Skills: gives students success with fundamental skills.
- **Level 3** Stroke Development: builds on the skills learned in Level 2 by providing additional guided practice.
- **Level 4** Stroke Improvement: develops confidence in the strokes learned and to improve other aquatic skills.
- **Level 5** Stroke Refinement: provides further coordination and refinement of strokes.

## Swim Camp

Four days of two and one-half hour sessions for incoming 5th through incoming 8th graders. Camp includes stroke instruction, lap swimming, basic water rescue, water games, basketball, diving lessons, speed swim instructions, free swim, synchronized swimming, and a great opportunity for triathlon water training. Each camper will receive a free swim camp t-shirt.

## Parent/Toddler Lessons

A two-week, Monday through Friday, half-hour program designed to help parents acclimate their toddlers to the water. Lots of fun for Mom, Dad, and Child.

# Pool Rules

## PROHIBITED:

horseplay, running, glass containers, smoking, alcohol, drugs, firearms, weapons, pets, public signs of affection, profanity, mattress-size flotation devices, and chewing gum

## RULES

- Bathers will shower prior to entering the pool if coming in with outside dirt.
- Bathers are not permitted in the grassy areas surrounding the pool.
- Eating and drinking is not permitted around the pool edge.
- Children under the age of 7 must be accompanied and supervised by a person at least 15 years of age, and this person must be in the water with the child.
- People with open sores, body rash, bandages, or a contagious disease will not be permitted in the pool.
- Flotation-type toys and games involving balls, frisbees, water guns, etc. are permitted ONLY at the discretion of, and with the permission of, the Pool Manager and/or Head Lifeguard.
- No cut-offs or any article of clothing not designed as bathing apparel will be permitted in the pool. Exception: solid-colored t-shirts worn as protection from the sun.
- For toddlers not potty-trained, swim diapers must be worn in order to enter the water.
- The posted diving board rules will be strictly enforced.
- Any act that infringes upon safety, pool sanitation, or moral conduct will be prohibited.
- No swimming/diving will be permitted in the deep end unless a lifeguard is on duty on the deep end stand, and there is also a lifeguard on the shallow end stand.
- No diving is allowed from the sides of the shallow end.
- The designated Lap Lane is to be used for Lap and Fitness swimming only. No other swimmers will be allowed in the lane.
- The Pool Manager and/or Head Lifeguard will rule on anything not covered above.

## Bad Weather Policy

The pool will be closed during electrical storms and other inclement weather watches or warnings. If inclement weather occurs after the facilities are open, then it will be up to the Pool Manager and/or Head Lifeguard to decide if the facilities will be shut down temporarily or for the remainder of the day. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.
